



About the Artistic Director

Margi Pietsch is heir to the legacy of a musical matriarchy. Raised by a mother who was a member of the Fulton Opera Workshop, and a grandmother who played organ in her church and taught piano in their home, she began playing piano at the age of four Throughout her childhood, she sang solos and in the children's choruses at the opera workshop, and at fifteen directed her first musical, South Pacific.

She studied music performance and pedagogy at Millersville University, where she won the Leo Ascher Musical Composition Award, and the James Hamilton and Lucretia Boyd-Hartzell Piano

Performance Award.


Margi has directed countless musicals for universities, high schools, and professional theaters throughout the area. In 1991, she served as musical director, conductor, orchestrator, arranger, and vocal coach for The Battle Cry of Freedom, performed at the Strand Theater in York, and the Harvard Club in New York City. Most recently, this summer she directed Oklahoma for the Dutch Apple Theater, where she will be directing this year's Christmas show

She assumed the position of artistic director for the Central Pennsylvania Womyn's Chorus in February of 1995, after having

served as accompanist last fall.

Margi is the namesake of her grandmother, Margaret Louise Pietsch; her mother is Maydell L. Pietsch-Stauffer.

She dedicates this concert to three special angels. "Your unseen presence is a true inspiration."


