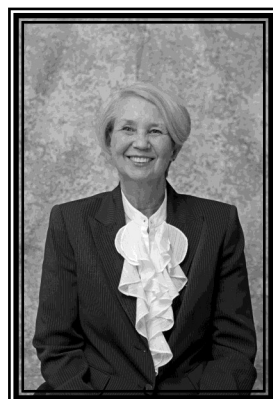

Es iz Nokh Haran Aza Blum (There is Still Such a Flower) was popular in Poland before WWII:

"When the golden sun sets, I steal silently down to the valley where my flower rests. I always see her, all around. Last sun rays fall like sapphire, with pure gold all around. The forest sings the Song of Songs for me, and my flower bows her head to me. Aha, sings the wind... for the last time. There is still such a flower, whose beauty no one knows. I love her in secret - she loves me in silence..."

The piece **Five Hebrew Love Songs** is comprised of poems set to music by the poet's husband. Each song captures a moment that the two shared together.

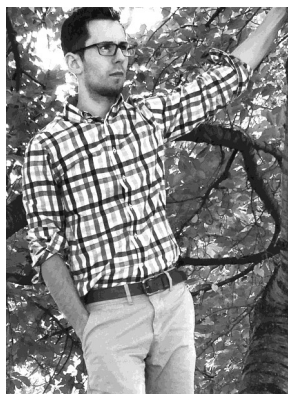

Jordan R. Markham, Artistic Director, studied at *The Peabody Conservatory of The Johns Hopkins University*. He is a classically-trained singer, having studied under Grammy-winning baritone, William Sharp, and soprano Susan Solomon Beckley of Bucknell University. He was a chorister at The National Cathedral and a chorister and soloist in The Handel Choir of Baltimore for two seasons. Throughout the past decade, Mr. Markham has performed with The Baltimore Symphony Orchestra, at Carnegie Hall, The Boston Symphony Hall, and The Jackie Gleason Theatre. He has been active in the musical scene for the past decade directing, accompanying, and acting in theaters throughout Pennsylvania and Maryland. He is currently serving as Organist and Director of Music at Trindle Spring Lutheran Church in Mechanicsburg.

Arlo Ehly, guest accompanist, is an active musician in the Central Pennsylvania region. He is organist at St. Mark Lutheran Church, Hanover. He has played for numerous recitals, competitions, and auditions at colleges and other performance venues. He recently became the accompanist for the concert choir at Gettysburg College. Arlo has been involved with productions as music director and pit musician for professional, university and high school theater. Mr. Ehly is a member of the York Chapter of the American Guild of Organists and the American Choral Directors Association. He graduated from Susquehanna University in 2014 and resides in Biglerville, Pennsylvania.



Renee Bartholomew, percussion, and Patricia George, percussion and bass, have played with many area bands. They often join CPWC for its concerts.

John Eaken, violinist, is a member of the Eaken Piano Trio. The Trio tours internationally and has released eight CDs, one of which was nominated for a Grammy. Mr. Eaken studied violin at the Settlement Music School and the New School of Music in Philadelphia, receiving a Bachelor of Science degree from Messiah College and a Master of Arts degree in Music Performance from Temple University. As a recitalist, John Eaken frequently performs throughout the United States. Mr. Eaken has also played repeat solo performances with The Harrisburg Symphony, The York Symphony, and the Shippensburg University Festival Orchestra. He is currently Concertmaster of the York Symphony.
